

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-80

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98064 WITH O'BRIEN KREITZBERG FOR THE RE-WRITE OF E&C'S MANUALS AT A PRICE OF \$133,548.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0104 (\$100,161.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 75% OF THE TOTAL COST) EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the FTA has requested that the Authority's E&C manuals meet all standard accepted practices and be in compliance with guidelines; and

WHEREAS, in order to satisfy FTA requirements, the Authority has deemed it necessary to retain a consultant to re-write the Project Design Execution and the Construction Management Manuals; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of O'Brien Kreitzberg located at 8 Penn Center, 21st Floor, 1628 John F. Kennedy Blvd., Philadelphia, PA 19103 was received on June 23, 1998; and

WHEREAS, after negotiations O'Brien Kreitzberg submitted an offer to provide services at a price of one hundred thirty-three thousand five hundred forty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$133,548.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of O'Brien Kreitzberg, as negotiated, to be the most advantageous to the Authority, price and all other factors considered, and therefore recommends the acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of O'Brien Kreitzberg, as modified by negotiations, be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous proposal for the re-write of the E&C manuals.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the re-write of the E&C manuals.

Section 3. That said contract shall be consistent with the proposal received from O'Brien Kreitzberg as amended by negotiations.


Section 4. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0104 in the amount of one hundred thirty-three thousand five hundred forty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$133,548.00).

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance of the contract to specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution take effect immediately upon its adoption.
