

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-81

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98071 WITH THE GREAT LAKES CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR PROJECT 27G – REHABILITATION OF THE TRANSIT TRACK BRIDGE OVER EUCLID AVENUE AT E. 120<sup>TH</sup> STREET - \$996,000.00 CAPITAL GRANT OH-030167 (\$796,800.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST)

WHEREAS, the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Company located at 6600 E. Schaaf Rd., Independence, Ohio 44131 in the amount of nine hundred ninety-six thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$996,000.00) was received for Project 27G – Rehabilitation of the Transit Track Bridge over Euclid Avenue at E. 120<sup>th</sup> Street on July 2, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

Section 1. That the bid of The Great Lakes Construction Company for the provision of construction services for Project 27G – Rehabilitation of the Transit Track Bridge over Euclid Avenue at E. 120<sup>th</sup> Street be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Great Lakes Construction Company to provide construction services for Project 27G – Rehabilitation of the Transit Track Bridge over Euclid Avenue at E. 120<sup>th</sup> Street.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA Capital Grant OH-030167 in the amount of nine hundred ninety six thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$996,000.00)

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
