

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-110

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98095 WITH THE SCHIRMER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT 24G – REHABILITATION OF THE TRISKETT REDLINE RAPID STATION - \$8,367,000.00 – CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0154 (\$6,693,600.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of the bid of the Schirmer Construction Company, located at 4197 W. 150<sup>th</sup> Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44135 for the construction of Project 24G, Rehabilitation of the Triskett Rapid Station was received on September 2, 1998 for the price of eight million three hundred sixty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$8,367,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Schirmer Construction Company to be the lowest responsible bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Schirmer Construction Company for the provision of construction services for Project 24G – Rehabilitation of the Triskett Rapid Station be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Schirmer Construction Company to provide construction services for Project 24G – Rehabilitation of the Triskett Rapid Station.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of Capital Grant OH-03-0154 in the amount of eight million three hundred sixty-seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$8,367,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1996-123, bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
