

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-125

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98136 WITH NOVELL, INCORPORATED, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MASTER NETWORK LICENSE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$28,945.00 (GENERAL FUND, INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET),

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized utilization of The State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program in Resolution 1990-69; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Act provides political subdivisions within the State of Ohio with the opportunity to participate in contracts executed by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H) (4), permits trustees of a regional transit authority to enter into agreements with the state to participate in said Program; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Authority to utilize the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of a Master License Agreement for NetWare software being upgraded by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Novell Incorporated, 6450 Rockside Woods Boulevard, Independence, Ohio for a Master License Agreement for NetWare software.


Section 2. That said contract is entered into under the authority granted by the Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43 (H) (4).

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund, Information Systems Department budget, in the amount of twenty-eight thousand, nine hundred forty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$28,945.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
