

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-148

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98107 WITH DIESEL RADIATOR COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF RADIATOR CORE ASSEMBLIES, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR, FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$96,420.00 – (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of the Diesel Radiator Company located at 1985 Janice Avenue, Melrose Park, IL 60160 for the furnishing of radiator core assemblies, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year was received on the 5th day of November, 1998, for unit prices set forth in said bid at a total not to exceed ninety-six thousand four hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$96,420.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of the Diesel Radiator Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of the Diesel Radiator Company received on November 5, 1998 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Diesel Radiator Company for the furnishing of radiator core assemblies, as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Inventory Department budget in an amount not to exceed ninety-six thousand four hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$96,420.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
