AUTHORIZING FREE SERVICE ON NEW YEAR'S EVE AND ON JANUARY 18, 1999

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to be a "a source of public pride" and a "visible positive contributor to the quality of life in the community"; and

WHEREAS, community and government organizations make a special effort to address the problem of drunk driving on New Year's Eve; and

WHEREAS, free service on New Year's Eve would provide an incentive for people to ride RTA if they are not in a condition to drive safely; and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 1999, eleven local museums will offer free admission in observance of the "Honor the Legacy" celebration on Martin Luther King, Jr., Day; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will offer free service to all customers from 11:00 PM on December 31, 1998, until 6:00 AM on January 1, 1999.

Section 2. That the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority will offer free service to all customers from 10:00 AM until 3:00 PM on January 18, 1999.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
