

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-6

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98133 WITH A.G. LICHTENSTEIN & ASSOCIATES FOR PROJECT 27I – A/E SERVICES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE AMBLER STREET TRANSIT TRACK BRIDGE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,500.00; CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0136 (\$96,400.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL PRICE).

WHEREAS, the proposal of A.G. Lichtenstein & Associates, Inc. located at 445 Hutchinson Avenue, Suite 800, Cleveland, Ohio 43235 for Project 27I, Architectural/Engineering (A/E) Services for the Rehabilitation of the Ambler Street Transit Track Bridge was received on November 12, 1998; and

WHEREAS, A.G. Lichtenstein & Associates, Inc. has agreed to perform the required services for the negotiated price of one hundred twenty thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$120,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems A.G. Lichtenstein & Associates, Inc. to be the most qualified provider of the required A/E Services and finds the negotiated price to be fair and reasonable for the services to be performed and, therefore, recommends acceptance thereof from the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the negotiated offer of A.G. Lichtenstein & Associates, Inc. be and is hereby accepted as the most advantageous to the Authority, price and all other factors considered, to provide A/E services for the Rehabilitation of the Ambler Street Transit Track Bridge as described under Project 27I.

Section 2. That the General Manger of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with A.G. Lichtenstein & Associates, Inc. to provide A/E services for the Rehabilitation of the Ambler Street Transit Track Bridge as described under Project 27I.

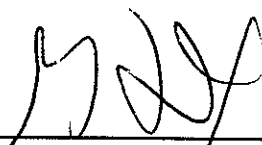
Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal dated November 12, 1998 as modified by negotiations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0136 in the amount of one hundred twenty thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$120,500.00).

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
