

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-12

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98145 WITH SOVEREIGN INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF CHEMICAL ICE MELTER, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS, FOR A TOTAL EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$98,400.00 – (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Sovereign Industries, Inc. located at 5340 Hamilton Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44114 for the furnishing of Chemical Ice Melter, as specified and as required for a period of two (2) years was received on the 3rd day of December, 1998, for unit prices set forth in said bid at a total not to exceed ninety-eight thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$98,400.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Sovereign Industries Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Sovereign Industries, Inc. received on December 3, 1998 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sovereign Industries, Inc. for the furnishing of Chemical Ice Melter, as specified and as required for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Inventory Department budget in an amount not to exceed ninety-eight thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$98,400.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon funding for future years; compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

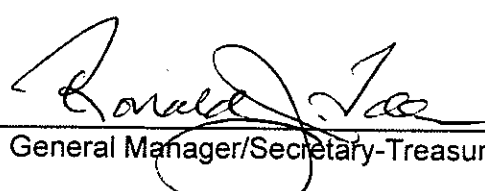
Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
