

RESOLUTION NO. 1999- 15

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 98160 WITH BURTON SCOT CORPORATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT 7.70 – EAST 222ND/EUCLID BUS LOOP REPAVING, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$44,990.00 – RTA CAPITAL FUND (ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Burton Scot Corporation, located at 14728 Maplewood Drive, Burton, Ohio 44024 for the construction of Project 7.70 – East 222nd/Euclid Bus Loop Repaving, was received on Wednesday, January 20, 1999 in the amount of forty-four thousand, nine hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$44,990.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Burton Scot Corporation to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Burton Scot Corporation, for Project 7.70 – East 222nd/Euclid Bus Loop Repaving be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Burton Scot Corporation for the construction of Project 7.70 – East 222nd/Euclid Bus Loop Repaving.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from RTA Capital Fund (Engineering and Construction Department budget) in the amount of forty-four thousand, nine hundred ninety & 00/100 dollars (\$44,990.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
