RESOLUTION NO. 1999-16

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 98134 WITH MAI ARCHITECTS-ENGINEERS-PLANNERS FOR ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR PROJECT 31C – ADA MODIFICATIONS TO GREEN ROAD STATION AT A PRICE OF \$70,000.00 – CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0136 (\$56,000.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the proposal of MAI Architects-Engineers-Planners, located at 1901 East 13th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44114-3599 for Design Services for Project 31C – ADA Modifications to the Green Road Rapid Station was received January 24, 1999; and

WHEREAS, MAI Architects Engineers-Planners has agreed to perform the desired services for the negotiated price of seventy thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$70,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manger deems MAI Architects-Engineers-Planners to be the most qualified provider of the desired A/E services and finds the negotiated price to be fair and reasonable and recommends acceptance thereof from the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MAI Architects-Engineers-Planners for design services for Project 31C – ADA Modifications to the Green Road Station.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0136, in the amount of seventy thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$70,000.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirement and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
