

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-27

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98169 WITH NORTH AMERICAN BUS INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF NON ASBESTOS, BOLT-ON BRAKE BLOCKS AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$119,480.30 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of North American Bus Industries located at 325 South Sandusky Street, Suite 100, Delaware, OH 43015 for the furnishing non asbestos, bolt-on brake blocks as specified and as required was received on the 4th day of February, 1999 for the unit prices set forth in said bid for an estimated amount of one hundred nineteen thousand four hundred eighty & 30/100 dollars (\$119,480.30); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of North American Bus Industries, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of North American Bus Industries, Inc. received on February 4, 1999 for the furnishing of non asbestos, bolt-on brake blocks be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with North American Bus Industries for the furnishing of non asbestos, bolt-on brake blocks as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Inventory Department budget at the unit prices stated for an amount not to exceed one hundred nineteen thousand four hundred eighty & 30/100 dollars (\$119,480.30).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
