

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-44

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 98167 WITH ORION BUS INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF BRAKE SHOES AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$96,338.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Orion Bus Industries, Inc. located at 165 Base Road, Oriskany, NY 13424 for the furnishing of brake shoes as specified and as required was received on the 25th day of February, 1999 at the unit prices set forth in said bid for a total amount not to exceed ninety-six thousand three hundred thirty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$96,338.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Orion Bus Industries, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Orion Bus Industries, Inc. received on February 25, 1999 for the furnishing of brake shoes be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Orion Bus Industries, Inc. for the furnishing of brake shoes as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Inventory Department budget at the unit prices stated for an amount not to exceed ninety-six thousand three hundred thirty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$96,338.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
