

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99026 WITH DELTA RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION INC FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT 23G-1 RED LINE RIGHT-OF-WAY REHABILITATION OF CATENARY SUPPORT STRUCTURES, RETAINING WALLS, AND DRAINAGE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,799,999.00 – CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0161(\$1,264,865.00) and CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0167 (\$535,134.00); (\$1,439,999.20 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc., located at 2648 West Prospect Road, Ashtabula, Ohio 44004 for the construction of Project 23G-1 - Red Line Right-of-Way Rehabilitation of Catenary Support Structures, Retaining Walls, and Drainage, was received on Tuesday, March 30, 1999 in the amount of one million, seven hundred ninety-nine thousand, nine hundred ninety-nine & 00/100 dollars (\$1,799,999.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc., for Project 23G-1 – Red Line Right-of-Way Rehabilitation of Catenary Support Structures, Retaining Walls, and Drainage be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Delta Railroad Construction Inc. for the construction of Project 23G-1, Red Line Right-of-Way Rehabilitation of Catenary Support Structures, Retaining Walls, and Drainage.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-03-0161, line 12.24.03 and Capital Grant OH-03-0167, line 12.24.03 in the amount of one million, seven hundred ninety-nine thousand, nine hundred ninety nine & 00/100 dollars (\$1,799,999.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
