

RESOLUTION NO. 1999-62

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99045 WITH PRECISION DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT 8.36 – BROOKLYN PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$44,338.00 – RTA CAPITAL FUND (ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc., located at 249 State Route 303, Streetsboro, Ohio 44241 for the construction of Project 8.36 – Brooklyn Pavement Replacement, was received on Wednesday, April 28, 1999 in the amount of forty-four thousand, three hundred thirty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$44,338.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc., for Project 8.36 – Brooklyn Pavement Replacement be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for the construction of Project 8.36 – Brooklyn Pavement Replacement.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from RTA Capital Fund (Engineering and Construction Department budget) in the amount of forty-four thousand, three hundred thirty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$44,338.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.


Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
