

RESOLUTION NO. 1999- 70

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99046 WITH NATIONAL ENGINEERING & CONTRACTING COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR PROJECT 20A, PHASE II-REHABILITATION OF THE CUYAHOGA VIADUCT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,997,500.00 (100% LOCAL FUNDS)

WHEREAS, the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Company, located at 12608 Alameda Drive, Cleveland, Ohio 44136 for construction services for Project 20A, Phase II-Rehabilitation of the Cuyahoga Viaduct was received on Tuesday, April 29, 1999 in the amount of seven million nine hundred ninety seven thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$7,997,500.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of National Engineering & Contracting Company for construction services for Project 20A, Phase II-Rehabilitation of the Cuyahoga Viaduct in the amount of seven million nine hundred ninety seven thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$7,997,500.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National Engineering & Contracting Company for construction services for Project 20A, Phase II-Rehabilitation of the Cuyahoga Viaduct.


Section 3. That said contract shall be funded through a \$6,945,000.00 State Infrastructure Bank Loan in which the repayment will occur with 100% Local Funds and the remaining \$1,052,500.00 will be funded through 100% Local Funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
