

RESOLUTION NO. 1999 - 83

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1998-147 TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPROPRIATION IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$56,650.00.

WHEREAS, RTA is involved with the multi-jurisdictional Caribbean/Gang Task Force.

WHEREAS, RTA derives revenue from seized and confiscated monies and/or properties of convicted drug dealers prosecuted by the Task Force.

WHEREAS, guidelines instituted by the State Attorney General's office restricts the use of these funds for law enforcement purposes.

WHEREAS, RTA has received disbursements from the Caribbean/Gang Task Force which they have not completely expended at this time.

WHEREAS, the Transit Police Department intends to use the remainder of these funds for law enforcement purposes to purchase specialized investigative and training equipment.

WHEREAS, no appropriation was made in the 1999 budget as this expenditure was unexpected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1: That Resolution No. 1998-147 be and it is hereby amended as follows:


