

RESOLUTION NO. 1999- 106

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99095 WITH DELTA RAILROAD CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PROJECT 23K- RED LINE TRACK RENEWAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,421,500.00 – CAPITAL GRANT OH-03-0178 (\$1,937,200.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc., located at 2648 West Prospect Road, Ashtabula, Ohio 44004 for the construction of Project 23K - Red Line Track Renewal, was received on Monday, August 9, 1999 in the amount of two million, four hundred twenty-one thousand, five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$2,421,500.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Delta Railroad Construction Inc., for Project 23K – Red Line Track Renewal be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Delta Railroad Construction Inc. for the construction of Project 23K, Red Line Track Renewal.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from pending Capital Grant OH-03-0178, in the amount of two million, four hundred twenty-one thousand, five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$2,421,500.00). Should said grant not be approved by the Federal Transit Administration, said contract shall be payable from 100% local funds.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1996-123; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
