

RESOLUTION NO. 1999- 132

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99076E WITH UNION EYE CARE CENTERS, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF VISION BENEFITS TO THE AUTHORITY'S EMPLOYEES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AT AN ESTIMATE OF \$108,000.00 - GENERAL FUND (VARIOUS DEPARTMENT BUDGETS).

WHEREAS, the proposal of Union Eye Care Centers, Inc., located at 20525 Center Ridge Road, Suite 360, Rocky River, Ohio 44116 for the furnishing of vision benefits to the Authority's employees for a one year period was received on July 7, 1999; and

WHEREAS, negotiations with Union Eye Care Centers, Inc. resulted in rates which will result in an estimated cost to the Authority of one hundred eight thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$108,000.00) base on the rates submitted at anticipated claims utilization; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer of Union Eye Care Centers, Inc., as modified through negotiations, to be the most advantageous to the Authority, price and all other factors considered, and therefore recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Union Eye Care Centers, Inc. received on July 7, 1999, as negotiated, be and the same is hereby accepted as the most advantageous to the Authority, price and other factors considered, to provide vision benefits to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority's employees for a one year period.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Union Eye Care Centers, Inc. for the provisions of vision benefits to the Authority's employees for a period of one year.


Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal dated July 7, 1999, as modified by negotiations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Various Department Budgets, in the not to exceed amount of one hundred eight thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$108,000.00).


Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon appropriations for future years; compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; he Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
