## RESOLUTION NO. 1999 -141

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO CONTRACT NO. 96098 WITH COYNE TEXTILE SERVICES FOR THE FURNISHING OF UNIFORMS AND LAUNDRY SERVICE (\$115,227.95 – GENERAL FUND, VARIOUS DEPARTMENTAL BUDGETS)

WHEREAS, by Resolution 1996-126 the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority had contracted with Coyne Textile Services for the provision of uniforms and laundry services for maintenance personnel for a period of three years in an amount not to exceed four hundred ninety five thousand three hundred ninety seven & 00/100 dollars (\$495,397.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager has utilized his change order authority to add an additional one hundred thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$100,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Contract 96098 is scheduled to expire on October 30, 1999; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the Authority to extend Contract 96098 until December 31, 1999 in order to permit uninterrupted service pending award to a new contract; and

WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of one hundred fifteen thousand two hundred twenty seven & 95/100 dollars (\$115,227.95) is required to complete the extended contract term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the price of Contract 96098 with Coyne Textile Services is hereby recognized as not to exceed five hundred ninety five thousand three hundred ninety seven and 00/100 dollars (\$595,397.00).
- Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to amend the contract with Coyne Textile Services for uniform and laundry service to increase the contract amount by the sum of one hundred fifteen thousand two hundred twenty seven & 95/100 dollars (\$115,227.95).
- Section 3. That the total amount of said contract shall not exceed seven hundred ten thousand six hundred twenty four & 95/100 dollars (\$710,624.95).
- Section 4. That said increase shall be payable out of the General Fund, Various Departmental Budgets.

Section 5. That all other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain in effect.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
