

RESOLUTION NO. 1999- 178

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99143A WITH OHIO DIVERSIFIED SERVICES, INC. FOR GENERAL TRADES CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR PROJECT 7.55 – TOWER CITY STATION PLATFORM RESTORATION AND STORAGE ROOM, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$865,225.00 – CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X306 (\$692,180.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of Ohio Diversified Services, Inc., located at 20226 Detroit Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44116 for the General Trades construction services for Project 7.55 – Tower City Station Platform Restoration and Storage Room, was received on Tuesday, December 7, 1999 in the amount of eight hundred sixty-five thousand, two hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$865,225.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Ohio Diversified Services, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Ohio Diversified Services, Inc., for General Trades construction services for Project 7.55 – Tower City Station Platform Restoration and Storage Room be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ohio Diversified Services, Inc. for General Trades construction services for Project 7.55 – Tower City Station Platform Restoration and Storage Room.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-X306, line 12.7A.00 in the amount of eight hundred sixty-five thousand, two hundred twenty-five & 00/100 dollars (\$865,225.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
