

RESCINDING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO KASTLE SOFTWARE ASSOCIATES, TO UPGRADE THE SECURITY AND ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM REQUIRED FOR YEAR 2000 COMPLIANCE – AWARDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 1999-87.

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is bringing mission critical equipment to Year 2000 compliance; and

WHEREAS, the award of a contract to Kastle Software Associates, located at 1501 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Virginia 22209, the original provider of the software systems, was adopted by Resolution No. 1997-163 on July 20, 1999, for a price set forth in said award of forty thousand & 00 dollars (\$40,000.00); and


WHEREAS, the Interim General Manager deems the award of Kastle Software Associates invalid due to the no-cost workaround discovered by the Transit Police and the supplier of the security and access control system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


