

RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 7

AUTHORIZING SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT NO. 2000-005 WITH MULTISYSTEMS FOR THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMATED DISPATCH SYSTEMS SOFTWARE UPGRADES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$29,600.00 – RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND (SERVICE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has determined the need to upgrade the current Automated Dispatch System (ADS) software from a Betrieve database and DOS operating environment to an Oracle database and Windows operating environment; and

WHEREAS, this upgrade is available through Multisystems located at 10 Fawcett Street, Cambridge, MA 02138, the original provider of GCRTA's current ADS system; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(H) (3) provides that competitive bidding is not required when the expenditure is for a renewal or negotiation of a lease or license for telecommunications or data processing equipment service or systems, or for upgrade of such equipment services or systems, or for the maintenance thereof as supplied by the original source or its successors or assigns ; and

WHEREAS, Multisystems has offered to perform said work at a negotiated price not to exceed twenty nine thousand six hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$29,600.00); and

WHEREAS, the Interim General Manager deems the negotiated price by Multisystems to be in the best interest of the Authority and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Interim General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a sole source contract with Multisystems for the furnishing of automated dispatch systems software upgrades.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable from the Service Management Department Budget, in an amount not to exceed twenty nine thousand six hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$29,600.00).

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1999-114, bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
