

RESOLUTION NO. 2000 – 9

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99157 WITH AIRTOUCH PAGING TO PROVIDE PAGING SERVICE ON A MONTHLY BASIS, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, WITH AN OPTION FOR ONE ADDITIONAL YEAR, AT A TOTAL PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$36,432.00 FOR THE TWO BASE YEARS (GENERAL FUND - INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Transit Authority has determined the need to obtain paging service on a monthly basis, as required, for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, the offer of AirTouch Paging located at 981 Keynote Circle, Suite 19, Cleveland, Ohio for providing such service was received on January 14, 2000 for the unit prices set forth in said proposal; and

WHEREAS, AirTouch Paging has offered to perform said work at a negotiated price not to exceed thirty six thousand four hundred thirty two & 00/100 dollars (\$36,432.00) for a two year period with a one year option at the same rates; and

WHEREAS, the Interim General Manager deems the negotiated price with AirTouch Paging to be in the best interest of the Authority and recommends acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of AirTouch Paging for furnishing paging service for two years, as required, be and the same is hereby accepted as being in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 2. That the Interim General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with AirTouch Paging for the furnishing of paging service, as required, for a period of two years with a one year option at the same rate.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Information Systems Budget, at a price not to exceed thirty six thousand four hundred thirty two and 00/100 dollars (\$36,432.00), for the base two years with an option for one additional year.

Section 4. That the General Manager be authorized to exercise the option for one additional year at the rates established for the base years of the contract.


Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon; compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
