

RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 50

AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
WITH THE BUTLER COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSIT
AUTHORITY FOR THE TRANSFER OF SIX (6) OBSOLETE 1991
CHAMPION CRT VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Butler County Regional Transit Authority has requested that the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority transfer six (6) obsolete CRT transit vehicles to meet current service level requirements, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43 (L) (4), the disposition of property by a regional transit authority to a department of the federal or state government, to a political subdivision of the state, or to any other governmental entity is exempt from the competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, the Butler County Regional Transit Authority is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the six (6) vehicles have exceeded their useful life and are scheduled for disposition by the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the transfer of these vehicles to the Butler County Regional Transit Authority to be an appropriate and responsible action and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to transfer title of ownership of the six (6) vehicles to the Butler County Regional Transit Authority.


Section 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
