

RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 52

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-034 WITH ANA LABORATORIES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF SPECTROCHEMICAL ANALYSIS SERVICES AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS AT AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$83,888.00) – (GENERAL FUND - BUS EQUIPMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Ana Laboratories, Inc. located at 641 Creek Rd., Bellmawr, NJ 08031 for the furnishing of spectrochemical analysis as specified and as required for a period of two (2) years was received on the sixth day of April, 2000, at unit prices resulting in an estimated total price not to exceed eighty three thousand eight hundred eighty-eight and 00/100 dollars (\$83,888.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Ana Laboratories, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsive bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Ana Laboratories, Inc. received on April 6,2000 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ana Laboratories, Inc. for the furnishing of spectrochemical analysis as specified and as required for a period of two (2) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Bus Equipment Department Budget in an amount not to exceed eighty-three thousand eight hundred eighty-eight and 00/100 dollars (\$83,888.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon funding for future years: compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
