

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-53

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2000-026 WITH CHEMICAL SOLVENTS, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF BUS SOAP (HEAVY-DUTY CLEANER/DEGREASER), AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$77,423.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Chemical Solvents, Inc., located at 3751 Jennings Road, Cleveland, OH 44109 for the furnishing of bus soap (heavy-duty cleaner/degreaser), as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year was received on March 22, 2000 for the unit prices set forth in said bid, in an amount not to exceed seventy-seven thousand four hundred twenty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$77,423.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Chemical Solvents Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Chemical Solvents, Inc., received on March 22, 2000 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chemical Solvents, Inc., for the furnishing of bus soap (heavy-duty cleaner/degreaser), as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget), in an amount not to exceed seventy-seven thousand four hundred twenty-three & 00/100 dollars (\$77,423.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
