

RESOLUTION NO. 2000 – 55

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 99165 WITH VERIZON WIRELESS (AIRTOUCH CELLULAR) TO PROVIDE CELLULAR PHONE SERVICE ON A MONTHLY BASIS, AS REQUIRED, FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, AT A TOTAL PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$31,200.00 (GENERAL FUND - INFORMATION SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Transit Authority has determined the need to obtain cellular phone service on a monthly basis, as required, for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, the offer of Verizon Wireless (AirTouch Cellular) located at 3 Summit Park, Suite 600, Independence, Ohio for providing such service was received on February 4, 2000 for the unit prices set forth in said proposal; and

WHEREAS, Verizon Wireless has offered to perform said work at a negotiated price not to exceed thirty one thousand two hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$31,200.00) for a two year period; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the negotiated price with Verizon Wireless to be in the best interest of the Authority and recommends acceptance by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Verizon Wireless for furnishing cellular phone service for two (2) years, as required, be and the same is hereby accepted as being in the best interest of the Authority.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Verizon Wireless for the furnishing of cellular phone service, as required, for a period of two years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the RTA General Fund, Information Systems Budget, at a price not to exceed thirty one thousand two hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$31,200.00), for the two years.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon; appropriation for future contract years; compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1999-114; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
