

RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 95

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-081A WITH NORTH AMERICAN BUS INDUSTRIES FOR FIVE ALLISON MODEL VR731RH TRANSMISSIONS FOR A PRICE OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY THREE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED ONE & 05/100 DOLLARS (\$143,401.05) – CAPITAL GRANTS OH-90-X222 (\$120,000.00) AND CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X361 (\$23,401.05) (\$114,720.84 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of North American Bus Industries located at 325 South Sandusky, Delaware, OH 43105 for the furnishing of five Allison VR731RH transmissions was received on the fifth day of July, 2000, at a unit price resulting in a total price of one hundred forty three thousand four hundred one and 05/100 dollars (\$143,401.05); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of North American Bus Industries be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of North America Bus Industries received on July 5,2000, be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and in the best interest of the Authority.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with North American Bus Industry for the provision of five Allison VR731RH transmissions as specified.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Grant OH-90-X222 and Capital Grant OH-90-X361 in the amount of one hundred forty three thousand four hundred one and 05/100 dollars (\$143,401.05);

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
