

RESOLUTION NO. 2000 - 128

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-098 WITH AMERITECH PUBLIC COMMUNICATIONS FOR PROVIDING PAY PHONE SERVICE FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS, REVENUE GENERATING (AMOUNT VARIABLE - BASED ON USAGE).

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority currently permits 135 pay phones throughout the Greater Cleveland area located at Rapid Stations, Loop Turnarounds, District Offices, Park & Rides, and Transit Centers; and

WHEREAS, having pay phones located on Authority property is deemed desirable for both public convenience and safety, as well as generating revenue; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of Ameritech Public Communications, located at 1020 Bolivar Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44115, was received to provide the best overall service and revenue plan for the type of pay phone activity generated at the GCRTA locations; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the offer Ameritech Public Communications, as negotiated, to be in the Authority's best interest and recommends the same to the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Ameritech Public Communications, as modified by negotiations, be accepted to be in the best interest of the Authority to provide pay phone service for a period of three years.


Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ameritech Public Communications for a term of three years to provide pay phone services.

Section 3. That the proceeds to the Authority shall be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority and contingent upon compliance by the contractor to Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligation of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
