

RESOLUTION NO. 2000 - 129

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-115 WITH JONES TECHNOLOGIES ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR PROJECT 45 - BUS SHELTERS PHASE VIII IN THE AMOUNT OF \$796,415.00 - CAPITAL GRANT OH-90-X337 (\$637,132.00 IN FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH REPRESENTS 80% OF THE TOTAL COST).

WHEREAS, the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc., located at 13836 Union Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44120 for the furnishing of Project 45 - Bus Shelters Phase VIII, was received on Wednesday, August 30, 2000 in the amount of seven hundred ninety-six thousand, four hundred fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$796,415.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc., for Project 45 - Bus Shelters Phase VIII be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jones Technologies Enterprises, Inc. for the furnishing of Project 45, Bus Shelters Phase VIII.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from Capital Grant OH-90-X337, in the amount of seven hundred ninety-six thousand, four hundred fifteen & 00/100 dollars (\$796,415.00).


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
