

RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 130

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2000-112 WITH VEHICLE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR THE FURNISHING OF BRAKE DRUMS AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$110,788.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program located at 11744 Parklawn Drive, Rockwell, MD 20852 for the furnishing of front and rear brake drums for the Authority's Flixible Metro and Nova RTS fleets as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year was received on August 22, 2000 for the unit prices set forth in said bid in a total amount not to exceed one hundred ten thousand seven hundred eighty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$110,788.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said items and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Vehicle Maintenance Program for the front and rear brake drums for the Authority's Flixible Metro and Nova RTS fleets, received on August 22, 2000 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Vehicle Maintenance Program for the furnishing of brake drums for the Flixible, Metro and Nova RTS as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Inventory Department Budget, in an amount not to exceed one hundred ten thousand seven hundred eighty-eight & 00/100 dollars (\$110,788.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
