## **RESOLUTION NO. 2000-143**

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2000-117 WITH NEOPART FOR THE FURNISHING OF BRAKE SHOES, AS SPECIFIED AND AS REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR IN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$133,222.00 (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Neopart located at 5051 Horseshoe Pike, Honey Brook, PA 19344 for the furnishing of front and rear brake shoes for the Authority's Flxible Metro and Nova RTS coaches as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year was received on September 12, 2000, for unit prices resulting in a total amount not to exceed one hundred thirty-three thousand two hundred twenty-two & 00/100 dollars (\$133,222.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Neopart to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Neopart for the front and rear brake shoes for the Authority's Flxible Metro and Nova RTS coaches received on September 12, 2000 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Neopart for the furnishing of brake shoes for the Fixible Metro and Nova RTS coaches as specified and as required for a period of one (1) year.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund (Inventory Department Budget), in an amount not to exceed one hundred thirty-three thousand two hundred twenty-two & 00/100 dollars (\$133,222.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
