

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 6

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-159 WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE STRAIGHT TRUCK CHASSIS WITH VAN BODY AND LIFT GATE AS SPECIFIED IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED-FORTY AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$57,940.00) - (RTA CAPITAL FUND – BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT).

WHEREAS, the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. located at 5715 Canal Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44125, for the furnishing of one straight truck chassis with van body and lift gate as specified was received January 4th, 2001 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of fifty-seven thousand nine hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$57,940.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. received on January 4, 2001 for a total price of fifty-seven thousand nine hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$57,940.00) be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck Sales, Inc. for one straight truck chassis with van body and lift gate as specified

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the GCRTA Capital Fund in the amount of fifty-seven thousand nine hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$57,940.00).

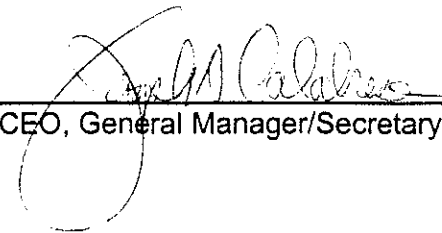

That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-65; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
