WHEREAS, RTA is involved with the multi-jurisdictional Caribbean/Gang Task Force.

WHEREAS, RTA derives revenue from seized and confiscated monies and/or properties of convicted drug dealers prosecuted by the Task Force.

WHEREAS, guidelines instituted by the State Attorney General's office restricts the use of these funds for law enforcement purposes.

WHEREAS, RTA has received notification of a disbursement award totaling \$97,236 from the U.S. Department of Justice for its participation in the Caribbean Gang Task Force.

WHEREAS, the Transit Police Department intends to use these funds for law enforcement purposes to purchase investigative and training equipment.

WHEREAS, no appropriation was made in the 2001 budget as this expenditure was unexpected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:
