

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-70

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-029 WITH HAR-TAL SERVICE INC. FOR PROJECT 9.00 FLUID DISPENSING SYSTEMS UPGRADE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,351.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, PARATRANSIT EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Har-Tal Service Inc., for Project 9.00 – Fluid Dispensing Upgrade at CRT was received on May 7, 2001, in the amount of thirty nine thousand three hundred fifty one dollars 00/100 (\$39,351.00); and

WHEREAS, the bid of Har-Tal was the sole bid received; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(B), when fewer than two responsive bids are received, a regional transit authority may negotiate a price with the sole responsive bidder and or may rescind the solicitation and re-procure the item; and

WHEREAS, negotiations resulted in acceptance of a price of thirty nine thousand three hundred fifty one dollars 00/100 (\$39,351.00) which was determined to be fair and reasonable to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Har-Tal Service, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Har-Tal Service Inc. for Project 9.00 Fluid Dispensing Systems Upgrade be and the same is hereby accepted.

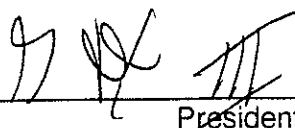
Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Har-Tal Service Inc. for Project 9.00.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund (Paratransit Equipment Department Budget), in the amount of thirty nine thousand three hundred fifty one dollars 00/100 (\$39,351.00).

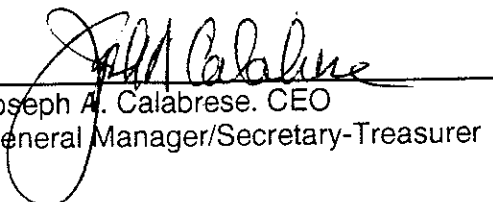
Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, it any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
