

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 74

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-031 WITH PRECISION DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION, INC. TO PROVIDE PAVING MAINTENANCE FOR PROJECT 7.36-STRONGSVILLE PARK-N-RIDE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,940.00 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc., for Project 7.36 - Strongsville Park-N-Ride Paving Repair was received on May 3, 2001, in the amount of fifty four thousand nine hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$54,940.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for Project 7.36 - Strongsville Park-N-Ride Pavement Repairs be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Precision Design & Construction, Inc. for Project 7.36 - Strongsville Park-N-Ride Paving Repairs.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund (Project Development & Engineering Department budget), in the amount of fifty four thousand nine hundred forty & 00/100 dollars (\$54,940.00).



That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
