

RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 76

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2001-030 WITH SUPERIOR ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR PROJECT 23P-HVAC/PLUMBING/ELECTRICAL TRADES-CONSTRUCTION OF THE SUBSTATION AT EAST 55TH STREET, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,054,000.00 – RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND – PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Superior Electric Company located at 1025 Dublin Road, Columbus, OH 43215 for Project 23P-HVAC/Plumbing/Electrical Trades/Construction of the Substation at East 55th Street and I-490, Cleveland, Ohio was received on May 11, 2001 in the amount of two million fifty-four thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$2,054,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Superior Electric Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Superior Electric Company for HVAC/Plumbing/Electrical Trades/Construction Services under Project 23P-Substation at East 55th Street and I-490, Cleveland, Ohio be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Superior Electric Company for HVAC/Plumbing/Electrical Trades/Construction Services under Project 23P-Substation at East 55th Street and I-490.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from applicable RTA Development Fund in the total amount of two million fifty-four thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$2,054,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
