

RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 82

AUTHORIZING SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT 2001-058 WITH DOMINION EAST OHIO FOR A FULL REQUIREMENTS TRANSPORTATION SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR NATURAL GAS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$600,000.00- (GENERAL FUND- FACILITIES MAINTENANCE & BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENTS BUDGETS).

WHEREAS, the offer of Dominion East Ohio, located at 1717 East 9th Street , Cleveland, Ohio 44114, for the furnishing of a Full requirements Transportation Service Agreement for a period of one year was received on June 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, after negotiations, a total price of six hundred thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$600,000.00) was agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio Revised Code, Section 306.43H(8) provides that competitive bidding is not required when a regional authority ,purchases the product or services of a public utility; and

WHEREAS, The General Manager deems the offer of Dominion East Ohio, as negotiated, to be advantageous to the Authority; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the offer of Dominion East Ohio, as negotiated, for the furnishing of a Full Requirements Transportation Service Agreement be and the same is hereby accepted as in the best interest of the Authority.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a Full Requirements Transportation Service Agreement.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Bus Equipment & Facilities Maintenance Department budgets, in the amount of six hundred thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$600,000.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the specification and addenda, if any; the affirmative action plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.


SECTION 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
