

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 83

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-049 WITH LEBIS ENTERPRISES, INC. TO PROVIDE DEMOLITION AND ASBESTOS ABATEMENT FOR PROJECT 9.12 WINDERMERE HEADSTART DEMOLITION PHASE II IN THE AMOUNT OF \$371,152.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc., 261 Massachusetts Avenue, Buffalo, N.Y. for Project 9.12 -Windermere Headstart Demolition Phase II was received on June 8, 2001, in the amount of three hundred seventy one thousand one hundred fifty-two and 00/100 dollars (\$371,152.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Lebis Enterprises, Inc. for Project 9.12 Windermere Headstart Demolition Phase II be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Lebis Enterprises, Inc. for Project 9.12 – Windermere Headstart Demolition Phase II.

Section 3. That said contract shall be in the amount of three hundred seventy one thousand one hundred fifty two and 00/100 dollars (\$371,152.00) payable from the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-03-0150, (\$296,921.60 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost.)

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2000-065; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

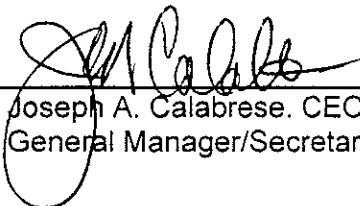
Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
