

RESOLUTION NO. 2001 - 89

AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO CONTRACT NO. 98095 WITH SCHIRMER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE REDUCTION OF CAISSON WORK AT THE TRISKETT STATION IN THE CREDIT AMOUNT OF \$30,500.00

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority by Resolution No. 1998-110 authorized a contract with Schirmer Construction Company for construction services to rehabilitate the Triskett Rapid Station, under Project No. 24G, in the amount of eight million three hundred sixty seven thousand & 00/100 dollars (\$8,367,000.00); and,

WHEREAS, the General Manager authorized additional changes in the scope of work totaling four hundred seventy three thousand eight hundred thirty five & 45/100 dollars (\$473,835.45); and,

WHEREAS, fewer quantities of caissons were required than were specified in the original contract work; and

WHEREAS, the contract allowed for a reduction in the total contract price for work scope not performed based on predetermined prices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the price of Contract No. 98095 with Schirmer Construction Company is hereby recognized as eight million eight hundred forty thousand eight hundred thirty five & 45/100 dollars (\$8,840,835.45)

Section 2. That the contract's predetermined price for quantities of caisson work which was not performed be accepted as a reduction in the total contract price.

Section 3. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to amend said contract to include the reduction of said work by an amount of thirty thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$30,500.00) for a new, total contract price of eight million eight hundred ten thousand three hundred thirty five & 45/100 dollars (\$8,810,335.45)


Section 4. That the General Manager be and he is hereby re-authorized to exercise his full change order authority under the GCRTA Procurement Policy, Section I-4.2.7.2, as applied to Contract No. 98095 with Schirmer Construction Company.

Section 5. That said change order shall be credited to the base contract price that was funded, in part, by Capital Grant OH-03-0154.

Section 6. That all other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain unchanged.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
