

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 93

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2000-172 WITH CLARKLIFT OF CLEVELAND, INC. FOR ONE (1) SKID STEER LOADER AND ATTACHMENTS AT A PRICE OF \$46,549.00 – RTA CAPITAL FUND (FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the bid of Clarklift of Cleveland, Inc., for one Skid Steer Loader and attachments was received on June 5, 2001, at a price of \$46,549.00; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Clarklift of Cleveland, Inc. was the sole bid received; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(B), when fewer than two responsive bids are received, a regional transit authority may negotiate a price with the sole responsive bidder or may rescind the solicitation and re-procure the item; and

WHEREAS, negotiations resulted in acceptance of the bid price of forty-six thousand five hundred forty-nine & 00/100 dollars (\$46,549.00) which was determined to be fair and reasonable to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, THE General Manager deems the bid of Clarklift of Cleveland, Inc., to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Clarklift of Cleveland, Inc., for one (1) Skid Steer Loader and attachments be and the same is hereby accepted.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Clarklift of Cleveland, Inc., for said Skid Steer Loader and attachments.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA Capital Fund in the amount of forty-six thousand five hundred forty-nine & 00/100 dollars (\$46,549.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.


Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
