

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-96

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-036 WITH NORTHEAST SUPPLY COMPANY TO PROVIDE CIVIL AND SITE WORK REQUIRED FOR PREPARATION FOR THE SOUTHGATE TRANSIT CENTER INCLUDING BUILDING THE BUS ROADWAY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$328,900.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Northeast Supply Company, 7895 Mayfield Road, Chesterland, Ohio 44126 for Project 18V, Southgate Transit Center Civil/Site Work was received on June 14, 2001, in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$328,900.00)

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Northeast Supply Company to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Northeast Supply Company, Project 18V, Southgate Transit Center Civil/Site Work be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Northeast Supply Company, for Project 18V, Southgate Transit Center Civil/Site Work.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable in the amount of three hundred twenty eight thousand nine hundred 00/100 dollars (\$328,900.00) payable from the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-90-X222, (\$263,120.00 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost.)

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, it any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

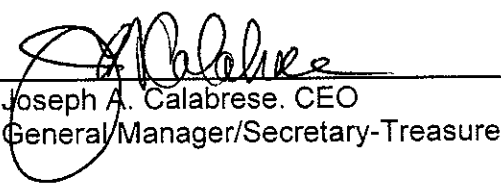
Section 5. That this resolution is contingent upon FTA approval of property acquisition.
