

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 97

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-056 WITH WAKE FOREST GARDEN CENTER TO PROVIDE TURF MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE AUTHORITY'S RAIL FACILITIES LOCATIONS, AS SPECIFIED, FOR THE PERIOD THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2001, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$73,420.00 (GENERAL FUND, FACILITIES MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority has a requirement to obtain turf maintenance services, as specified, for the period through December 31, 2001, for the rail facilities at approximately 45 Authority owned rail locations in the greater Cleveland area; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center, located at 4588 Lee Rd, Cleveland, Ohio 44128 for the furnishing of turf maintenance services, as specified, for the period through December 31, 2001 was received on June 27, 2001, in an amount not to exceed seventy three thousand four hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$73,420.00) for the period; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Wake Forest Garden Center for providing turf maintenance services, as specified, for the period through December 31, 2001 be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wake Forest garden Center for furnishing of turf maintenance services, as specified, for the period through December 31, 2001 at a cost not to exceed the amount of seventy three thousand four hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$73,420.00).

Section 3. That the said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund, Facilities Maintenance Department Budget, in an amount not to exceed seventy three thousand four hundred twenty & 00/100 dollars (\$73,420.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
