## RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 104

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO CONTRACT 97155 WITH MEDTOX LABORATORIES, INC. TO PROVIDE DRUG & ALCOHOL TESTING AND COLLECTION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF\$28,750.00 (GENERAL FUND, OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority identified a need to purchase Drug & Alcohol Testing and Collection Services; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1998-55, the Board of Trustees authorized a contract with Medtox Laboratories Inc. 402 West County Road, Saint Paul, Minnesota, 55112 to provide Drug & Alcohol Testing and Collection Services for a two-year period with a one year option, at rates resulting in a price not to exceed \$171,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager authorized an increase to the contract price in the amount of \$99,695.00; and

WHEREAS, due to more tests requiring immediate results than anticipated at the time of contract award, it is necessary to increase the price of said contract by an additional \$28,750.00; and

WHEREAS, said amount is in excess of the remaining General Manager's delegated change order authority.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

- Section 1. That the price of Contract No. 97155 with Medtox Laboratories, Inc. to provide Drug & Alcohol Testing & Collection Services is hereby recognized as not to exceed two hundred seventy thousand six hundred ninety-five and 00/100 dollars (\$270,695.00).
- Section 2. That the General Manager be and he hereby is authorized to amend Contract No. 97155 with Medtox Laboratories, Inc. to provide Drug & Alcohol Testing & Collection Services to increase the total price of said contract.
- Section 3. That said amendment shall be payable from the General Fund, Office of Small Business and Employment Opportunity Department budget, in the amount of twenty-eight thousand seven hundred fifty 00/100 dollars (\$28,750.00) for a total contract price not to exceed two hundred ninety-nine thousand four hundred forty-five and 00/100 dollars (\$299,445.00).
  - Section 4. That all other terms and conditions of said contract shall remain unchanged.
- Section 5. That the General Manager be and he is hereby re-authorized to exercise his full change order authority under the GCRTA Procurement Policy, Section I-4.2.7.2, as applied to said contract.
