

RESOLUTION NO. 2001 – 110

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR PILOT PROGRAMS ON AUTHORITY PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Authority to encourage new and innovative activities and ancillary services that enhance the image of the Authority; that improve the financial health of the Authority; and that focus on the convenience of the customers thereby helping retain and promote ridership; and

WHEREAS, new customer service programs are most effectively implemented when subject to pilot testing; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it to be in the best interest of the Authority to authorize the General Manager to enter into Pilot Programs that facilitate the policy stated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the CEO/General Manager be and is hereby authorized to enter into contracts in furtherance of this Pilot Program Resolution, which contracts shall not exceed six (6) months in duration.

Section 2. That if any such pilot program involves a procurement, then that procurement shall be conducted in accordance with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority Procurement Manual and applicable state and federal law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
