

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 153

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT 2001-080 WITH SOVEREIGN INDUSTRIES INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF CHEMICAL ICE MELTER FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$150,654.00 -GENERAL FUND (INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Sovereign Industries, Inc., located at 5340 Hamilton Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44114, for the furnishing of chemical ice melter for a period of three years was received on August 27, 2001, at a price not to exceed \$150,654.00; and

WHEREAS, the unit prices bid for one hundred pound boxes are \$14.48 for the first two years and \$15.35 for the third year; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Sovereign Industries, Inc., to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Sovereign Industries Inc., for chemical ice melter for a period of three years, at the unit prices specified, be and the same is hereby accepted.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sovereign Industries Inc., for chemical ice melter for a period of three years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable from the RTA General Fund (Inventory Department Budget) at a price not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand six hundred fifty four & 00/100 dollars (\$150,654.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon funding for future years; compliance by the contractor with the Specifications and Addenda thereto, if any, the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064 bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
