

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-156

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-132-B WITH D. E. WILLIAMS ELECTRIC, INC. TO PROVIDE AND INSTALL NEW ELECTRICAL AND SECURITY SYSTEMS FOR THE INTEGRATED COMMUNICATION CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$269,940.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide electrical systems of power, lighting, fire alarm and security for the Integrated Communication; and

WHEREAS, the bid of D.E. Williams Electric, Inc. to provide electrical services for Project 44B, Integrated Communication Center was received on November 7, 2001 in the amount of \$296,940.00; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of D.E. Williams Electric, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid for electrical services from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of D. E. Williams, Inc. for electrical services for Project 44B, Integrated Communication Center be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with D. E. Williams Electric, Inc. for electrical services for Project 44B, Integrated Communication Center.


Section 3. That said contract shall be in the amount of two hundred ninety six thousand nine hundred forty 00/100 dollars (\$296,940.00) payable out of the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-90X306 (\$237,552.00 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, it any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.


Section 5. That this resolution is contingent upon compliance by the Contractor, prior to execution of the contract, with all requirements of the solicitation regarding eligibility for award.
