

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 159

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-128 WITH CRAWFORD FENCE & GUARDRAIL, INC. TO REPLACE MAIN ENTRANCE GATES AT CENTRAL RAIL MAINTENANCE FACILITY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$67,000 (RTA CAPITAL FUND, \$32,500 PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET AND \$34,500 TRANSIT POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, new gates and access controls required to replace the existing inoperative gate system for Grand Avenue entrance at Central Rail; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Crawford Fence and Guardrail, Inc. with office at 3076 Albion Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44120 for Project 9.26, Replacement of Main Entrance Gates at Central Rail Maintenance Facility was received on November 6, 2001 in the amount of \$67,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Crawford Fence and Guardrail, Inc. was the sole bid received; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 306.43(B), when fewer than two responsive bids are received, a regional transit authority may negotiate a price with the sole responsive bid or may rescind the solicitation and re-procure the item; and

WHEREAS, negotiations resulted in acceptance of the bid price of sixty seven thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$67,000.00) which was determined to be fair and reasonable to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Crawford Fence & Guardrail, Inc. to be a responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Crawford Fence and Guardrail, Inc. for Project 9.26, Replacement of Main Entrance Gates at CRMF be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Crawford Fence and Guardrail, Inc., Project 9.26, Replacement of Main Entrance Gates at CRMF.

Section 3. That said contract shall be in the amount of sixty seven thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$67,000.00) payable out of the RTA Capital Fund, \$32,500 Project Development & Engineering Department Budget and \$34,500 Transit Police Department Budget.


Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
