

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 161

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-097 WITH LYDEN OIL CO.,
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRANSMISSION FLUID, AS SPECIFIED AND AS
REQUIRED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$134,400.00. (GENERAL FUND, INVENTORY DEPARTMENT
BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the bid of Lyden Oil Co., located at 3711 LeHarps Road, Youngstown,
OH 44515 for the furnishing of transmission fluid, as specified and as required for a period of
two (2) years was received on October 3, 2001 at unit prices resulting, in an amount not to
exceed one hundred thirty four thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$134,400.00); and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Lyden Oil Co., to be the lowest
responsive bid from a responsible bidder and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of
Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater
Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Lyden Oil Co., for providing transmission fluid as required
for a period of two (2) years received on October 3, 2001 in an amount not to exceed one
hundred thirty four thousand four hundred & 00/100 dollars (\$134,400.00) be and the same is
hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract with Lyden Oil Co., for the furnishing of transmission fluid, as
specified and as required for a period of two (2) years.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the (General Fund, Inventory
Department Budget), in an amount not to exceed one hundred thirty four thousand four hundred
& 00/100 dollars (\$134,400.00).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the
Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification and Addenda, if
any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064;
bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual
obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
