

RESOLUTION NO. 2001- 189

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT NO. 2001-139 WITH D. E. WILLIAMS ELECTRIC, INC. TO PROVIDE ELECTRICAL SERVICES FOR ADA MODIFICATIONS TO THE CEDAR/UNIVERSITY STATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$111,454.00 (RTA DEVELOPMENT FUND, PROJECT DEVELOPMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT BUDGET)

WHEREAS, the Authority deems it necessary to obtain electrical services for the ADA modifications for the Cedar/University Station; and

WHEREAS, the bid of D .E. Williams Electric, Inc. for Project 24K1, Cedar/University Station ADA Modifications, Electrical Services was received on December 6, 2001 in the amount of \$111,454.00; and

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of D. E. Williams Electric, Inc. to be the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder for said services and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of D. E. Williams Electric, Inc. for Electrical Services for Project 24K1, Cedar/University ADA Modifications be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with D. E. Williams Electric, Inc. for the electrical portion of Project 24K1, Cedar/University Station ADA Modifications.


Section 3. That said contract shall be in the amount of one hundred eleven thousand four hundred fifty four and 00/100 dollars (\$111,454.00) payable out of the RTA Development Fund, including but not limited to, Capital Grant OH-03-0186 (\$89,164.00 in Federal Funds, which represents 80% of the total cost).

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specifications and Addenda, thereto, it any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 2001-064; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
